In-text citations. An in-text citation is a concise way to show the reader where the original idea came from and to give credit to the original author. Use one every time you quote or paraphrase a source. Include the author's last name and the year of publication.

APA. APA is an author/date based style. This means emphasis is placed on the author and the date of a piece of work to uniquely identify it.

One author, two publications. Order by year of publication, the earlier one first. Same year of publication for both - add 'a' and 'b' after the year, inside the brackets. Include this in the in text citation. example: Baheti, J. R. (2001a).
