Lord Ayyappa is the presiding deity at Sabarimala residing in the hilly forest in Naishtik Brahmachari (eternal celibate) state. Till the Supreme Court today struck down Rule 3 (b) of the Kerala Hindu Places of Public Worship (Authorisation of Entry) Rules, 1965 declaring it unconstitutional, women of menstruating age (10-50 years) were not allowed to enter the temple.

As advised by the Lord, the Raja of Pandalam constructed the Ayyappa temple at Sabarimala. It is also believed that there already existed the DharmaSastha temple at Sabarimala, one of the 64 temples established by Parasurama, and Lord Ayyappa merged into the deity there.

At Kulathuppuzha, the Lord is worshipped as an infant boy, at Aryankavu as an adolescent on the verge of matrimony and at Achankovil, he is depicted as a 'grihasthashrami' with his wives, Poorna and Pushkala. However, on Sabarimala Lord Ayyappan/Dharmashastha is a brahmachari in a state of eternal bliss or Samadhi, holding 'chinmudra'.

All about sabarimala temple and swami sabarimala ayyappan ...

During a clash, Ayyappan got killed. His uncle,Perissery Pillai, constructed the KOCHAMPALAM - an old small Sastha temple - at Erumeli, opposite the VAVAR PALLY (MOSQUE), constructed by Muslims in memory of Vavar swamy. After the demise of Ayyappan people thought that he was the avathar of Lord Sastha and began to worship him.

Sabarimala-The pilgrimage is a symbol of love, equality ...

At Sabarimala, the Sastha Lord is worshipped as Ayyappan or Dharmasasta. It is believed that the prince of the Pandalam dynasty, who was an avatar of Lord Ayyappan, meditated at the Sabarimala temple and ultimately became one with the Divine. The place where he meditated is now the Manimandapam.

Ayyappa Temple, Sabarimala (Kerala) | Ayyappa Swamy Temple

Ayyappan (Sastha or Dharmasastha or Manikandan) is a Hindu deity, particularly popular in the South Indian state of Kerala.Lord Ayyapa is considered to be the union of Lord Vishnu and Shiva. Although the worship of Ayyapa was prevalent across the world, the early ages of expansion of Christianity and medieval expansionism of Islam confined its worship to South India.
